COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment Tip Sheet

1. The Oklahoma State Health Department has videos that demonstrate how to register on the portal and the process for booking an appointment. Find both at [Oklahoma.gov/covid19/vaccine-information.html](https://oklahoma.gov/covid19/vaccine-information.html)
2. The Oklahoma State Health Department requires appointments to be added during the same time frame each week: **Wednesdays after 5 pm and Thursday mornings before 9 am. This is the best time to regularly check for appointments.**
3. **Check often.** Knowing the times appointments are entered helps, but sometimes cancelations are made, or changes are made.
4. **Get alerted via text or email when new appointments are added.**
Visit vaccine-alerts.com to sign-up to receive text alerts, email alerts, and to view an availability map. Note: *The Vaccine Alerts website is in no way connected to the Oklahoma State Health Dept., nor can the agency verify the accuracy of the information contained within it.*
5. **Are you willing to drive out of Stillwater or Payne County?** Extending your search parameters will show appointments in other locations and may increase your chances of getting a vaccination sooner.
6. **OSU is offering vaccination appointments to alumni living in Payne, Creek, Kay, Lincoln, Noble, Pawnee, and Osage counties.** Call (405) 744-7665 to check on appointments.
